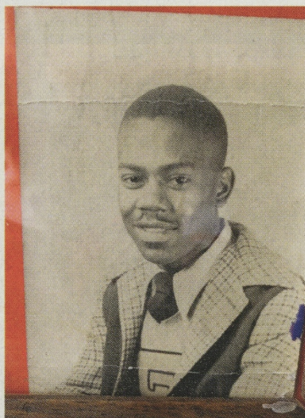


Englewood-Teaneck (NJ) Alumni Stays Connected During the Pandemic: Honors Senior Kappa and 70-Plus Year Member
