Standards for Awarding the ETAC -- Kappa Alpha Psi Scholarships

1. Student must be an African American male attending high school in the following areas: Englewood, Hackensack, and/or Teaneck -- **Please note: Exceptions to this criteria is at the discretion of the DSCF**
2. A Candidate must be a graduate in June of the year in which the scholarship is given and should have been accepted in an institution of higher learning – **Please note: If selected, recipients will be awarded monies within one year of being fully matriculated in a college and/or university. Additionally, if the student defers his enrollment, he must properly notify the chapter accordingly, and will remain eligible for one year in order to receive the scholarship**
3. All applicants must provide a standard passport photo with their application
4. A letter of acceptance from the institution that the student plans to attend must be submitted with the application
5. An official high school transcript must accompany the application
6. All candidates are required to attend a formal interview -- **Please note: Proper attire is required for the interview, i.e., suit or jacket, shirt, tie, and shoes (if in-person, no sneakers will be allowed)**
7. Awards will be granted upon proof of actual enrollment in a college or university. A receipt from the Bursar's Office will ensure your scholarship award
